II. Recap of previous meetings/events:

All of the past meeting agendas and minutes are posted on the website ([www.kanedupageswcd.org](http://www.kanedupageswcd.org)). Candice Jacobs recapped the last technical meeting that was held on 9.23.2011 and that we will be trying to combine the two groups together for a meeting in February. Kelsey Musich announced that volunteers are needed to assist with the Watershed Inventory and she introduced a map showing the quarter sections, select stream segments, and gullies that need to be visited in the field. A question was brought up by one of the residents asking what the conclusion of the Tyler Creek Watershed Group/Plan. Musich recapped the process and the implementation of their plan.

III. Presentations:

Kelsey Musich, KDSWCD presented on water quality and the impacts of pollutants on the watershed. She first started with the 3 segments of the Fox River that are

impaired and what they are impaired for and then she asked the group what everyone's idea of a pollutant is. The list as follows: salt, chemicals, nitrates, oil, suspended particles, natural material in an unnatural state, and non native species' pollen/seeds.

IV. Watershed Inventory Update:

The Watershed Assessment, timeframe, location, and results were tabled until next meeting.

V. Watershed Action Plan update:

- a. Landowner Ideas/Concerns: The watershed action plan will be brought to every meeting to collect additional landowner concerns. The first addition was a industrial park located at Northwest Parkway and Randall Road has naturalized detention to the north of the park with low flow channel that flows east under Randall Road to Sleepy Hollow Road toward the Tollway (I-90). Some additional information needed such as acreage of drainage area, flow rates, ect.
- b. Project Recommendations: Musich introduced the project submittal sheet and how the watershed action plan will be put into a formal chart document for the plan. A November 1<sup>st</sup> deadline was established for project submittals.
